FIRST AID COURSES

This will introduce and equip people with the knowledge and the skills to confidently administer CPR, use a public accessible AED, place someone in the recovery position and help a choking victim, plus treat a casualty who is bleeding or suffered burns. Will also cover the recognition and treatment of some medical emergencies, i.e. Heart attack, Diabetes, Epilepsy, Head Injuries etc.

The **First Aid at Work** (3 day) and the **Emergency First Aid** (1 day) training courses provide the comprehensive set of practical skills needed by first aiders in most workplaces to become a confident first aider at work giving both the ability, and the knowledge to deal with first aid emergencies.

Both these courses meets the standards required to help comply with Health and Safety (First aid) regulations.

Children's First Aid for Parents is a Basic First Aid course aimed at helping parents or carers to react to basic first aid situations in the home. This is not a paediatric first aid course. The course covers CPR, AED, burns, choking, bleeds, head injuries and other similar medical conditions.

FOOD HYGIENE COURSES

To build on existing experience, knowledge and skills with the addition of introducing food hygiene regulations to help anyone working with food preparation, cooking, serving and cleaning in their roles.

Contains subject material to comply with food handling regulations to Level 2 Food Hygiene Standard.

DEMENTIA FRIENDS COURSES

Dementia training for individuals or groups of people who have an interest in learning about the basics of dementia.

This friendly course acts as an introduction to dementia and is ideally suited for someone who has found their lives being involved with dementia through caring for someone living with dementia or for someone who may occasionally meet someone living with dementia.
